## **President's Message:**

#### **Consolidating AMFCE....**

The current Presidency / Executive, which started somewhere in September 2020, has gone through its lot of ups-and-downs, not only because of the difficult Covid circumstances, but also because of a thorough re-structuring and consolidation of AMFCE. Difficult times always requires more effort to make things progress, and yet, all effort yields concrete results: AMFCE has seen the burgeoning of new projects such as AWE and COMFWB, existing structures such as the Australian mentoring program (which feeds into the BWB program) and AMFCE's constitution have taken new forms and shape, membership has been consolidated and has more than tripled, collaboration, both with partner institutions from the private, public and parastatal bodies as well as internally within the members have been strengthened... all these being measures which will inevitably be spearheading great openings in the future...

A new body is now taking shape, consisting of active Past Presidents and Past Executive members, which will report to the elected Executive team, and will handle existing projects as from now onwards, so that the Executive can look after the day-to-day operations, keep existing members thoroughly engaged, and aspire to take on new projects... Such a structure will set the foundation for an effective operating system, that will not only sustain the existing system but also pave the way for yet more projects and initiatives...

And as we step into 2023 and the foundations for a further boosting up of AMFCE is being established, we can only aspire to greater heights... with a proper mix of the 'old' and the 'new' and a fluid blend of the older and newer generation of AMFCE. The sky is now the limit....

# > Sextortion – Incidence on entrepreneurship and businesses, held on the 4<sup>th</sup> October 2022 at the Suffren



Deep-sighted discussions on reforms that may be brought to the current system in Mauritius was also raised, highlighting the need for us, AMFCE, to get involved in the fight to prevent sexual abuse at work; definitely food-for-thought for AMFCE's future initiatives to further the women entrepreneurship cause!
