BUSINESS WITHOUT BORDERS (BWB)


AMFCE has reached the end of its first cohort of BWB and is actively preparing itself for the Graduation, tentatively scheduled for end of November 2021. Amidst the gloomy Covid background and the closure of our frontiers, the BWB project, which has a regional and global outreach, has been able to overcome stumbling blocks by embracing new opportunities and avenues (mainly through digitalisation), and proudly ends with a resounding success rate of 70%. Unfortunately, there has been some dropouts and some business closures, but amidst amazing resilience and growth for the majority of mentees.

And it is with a lot of enthusiasm and buzz that AMFCE closes BWB 2020-21 program through a series of Webinars, designed to reinforce and spread the knowledge gained, to entrepreneurs looking for tips to grow their business, refine their strategic thinking and strengthen leadership skills.


